



HIPAA Compliance Checklist

1. Privacy Rule Compliance

- Designate a Privacy Officer
- Develop and implement privacy policies and procedures
- Conduct a thorough review of all uses and disclosures of PHI
- Implement appropriate safeguards to protect PHI
- Provide privacy training to all workforce members
- Develop and distribute a Notice of Privacy Practices
- Establish a process for individuals to request access to their PHI
- Create a process for amending PHI upon request
- Implement a system for tracking disclosures of PHI
- Establish agreements with Business Associates



2. Security Rule Compliance

- Designate a Security Officer
- Conduct a risk analysis of electronic PHI (ePHI)
- Implement appropriate administrative safeguards:
 - Security management process
 - Assigned security responsibility
 - Workforce security
 - Information access management
 - Security awareness and training
 - Security incident procedures
 - Contingency plan
 - Evaluation
- Implement appropriate physical safeguards:
 - Facility access controls
 - Workstation use and security
 - Device and media controls
- Implement appropriate technical safeguards:
 - Access control
 - Audit controls
 - Integrity controls
 - Transmission security
- Develop and implement security policies and procedures
- Regularly review and update security measures

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3. Breach Notification Rule Compliance

- Develop and implement a breach notification policy
- Establish procedures for identifying and reporting breaches
- Create a process for assessing the probability of PHI compromise
- Develop templates for breach notifications
- Establish timelines for notifying individuals, HHS, and media (if applicable)
- Implement a system for documenting breach incidents and responses



4. Enforcement Rule Compliance

- Understand HIPAA enforcement processes and penalties
- Establish internal disciplinary policies for HIPAA violations
- Develop a process for responding to OCR investigations or audits
- Maintain documentation of all HIPAA compliance efforts



5. Organizational Requirements

- Conduct regular HIPAA compliance audits
 - Implement a document retention policy
- Establish a process for updating policies and procedures
- Develop and maintain an inventory of systems containing PHI
- Implement a change management process for systems containing PHI
- Establish a process for managing Business Associate relationships
- Conduct regular workforce training on HIPAA compliance



6. Documentation and Record-Keeping

- Maintain all required HIPAA-related documentation for six years
- Document all policy and procedure reviews and updates
- Keep records of all training sessions and attendees
- Maintain logs of security incidents and breach notifications
- Document all risk assessments and mitigation efforts



7. Ongoing Compliance Management

- Schedule regular compliance committee meetings
- Stay informed about HIPAA updates and changes
- Conduct periodic reassessments of HIPAA compliance
- Implement a process for addressing compliance gaps
- Regularly review and update Business Associate Agreements
- Conduct annual HIPAA training for all workforce members
